



Storage conditions for board

In order to maintain the original, good quality of the board, it is important to secure good storage conditions for the material.

Unused paperboard, both sheets and reels, should always be kept wrapped in its original packaging. Paperboard needs to be stored in a covered, dry and airy warehouse. Direct sunlight as well as big variation in humidity and temperature should be avoided during the storage. Access of pests and birds into the warehouse needs to be prevented.

Before the board is converted it needs to be left in conditions similar to those of its converting for some time. No exact time for this period can be provided as it depends on the volume of the board and the difference between the conditions of the converting room and the warehouse (see separate guidelines from Pankaboard). The bigger the difference in temperature of these two locations, the longer the time paperboard should be able to adjust for the converting conditions.

Quality of the board products manufactured by Pankakoski Mill Oy is guaranteed for one year from the time of production, given that the products are stored according to the recommendations above.
